- Please include your name at the top of each page.
- Stay within the suggested word counts for each section.
- Be thoughtful, specific, and personal in your responses.
- Incomplete or handwritten applications may not be considered.

- Passion for Career Path (20 points)
- Community Impact (20 points) - Demonstrates a desire to positively contribute to the community.
- Experience & Effort (20 points)
- Character & Resilience (20 points) - Evidence of perseverance, responsibility, and personal growth.
- Future Goals & Vision (10 points)
Clear direction and thoughtful career goals.
- Financial Need (10 points – optional consideration)
Consideration of financial barriers to continuing education.
